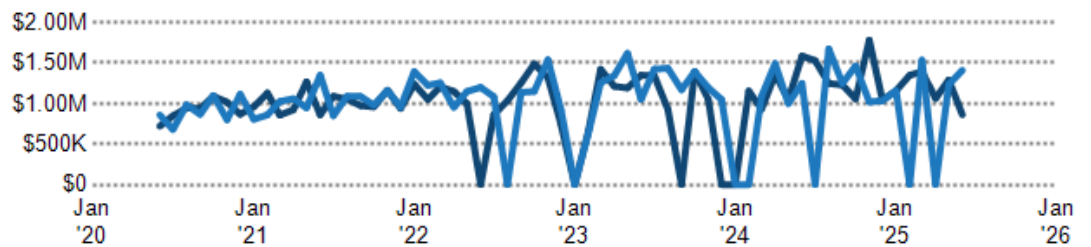

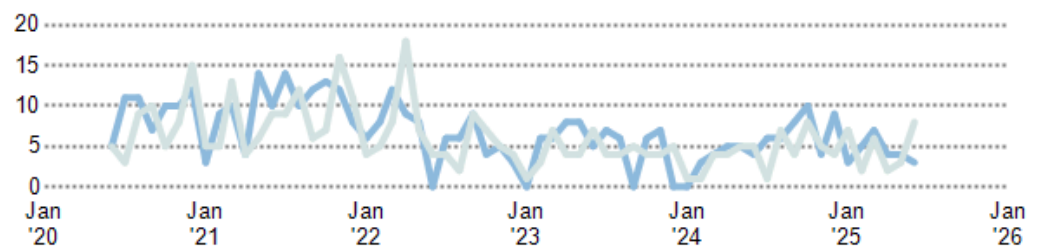

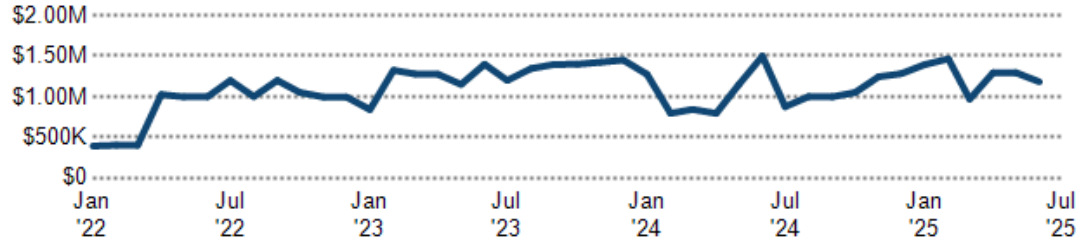

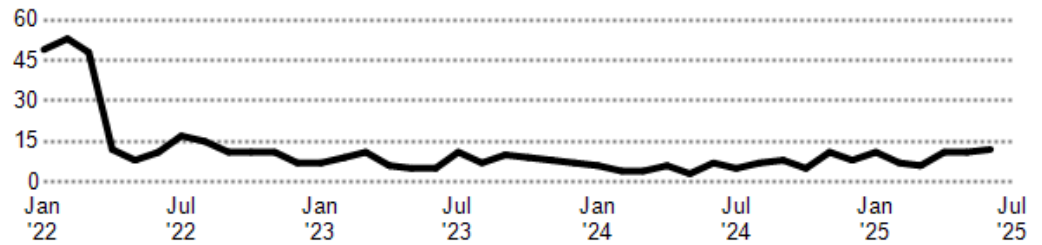

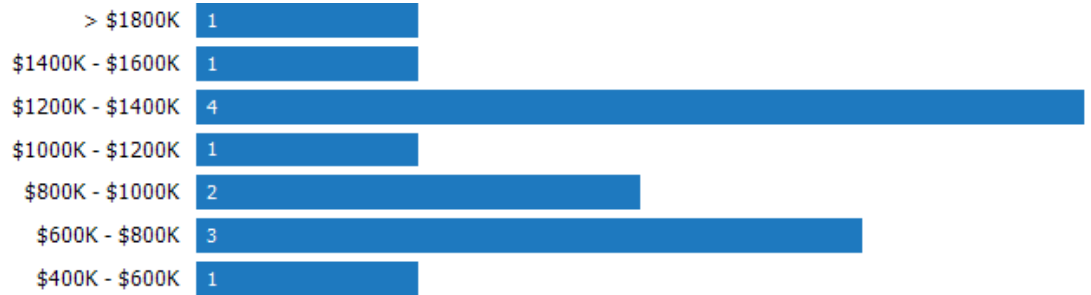

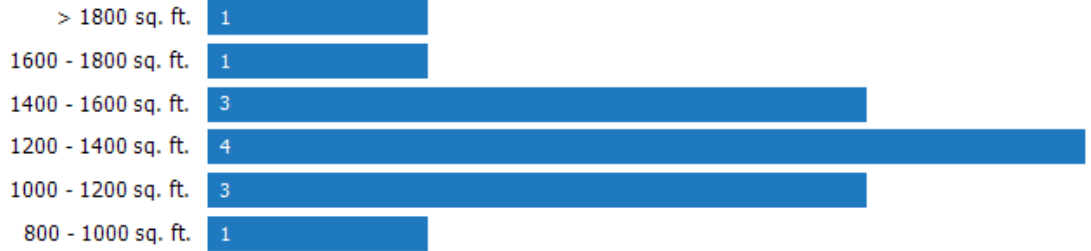

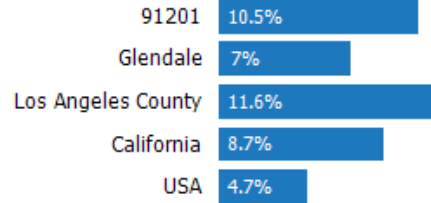

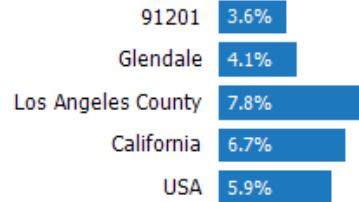

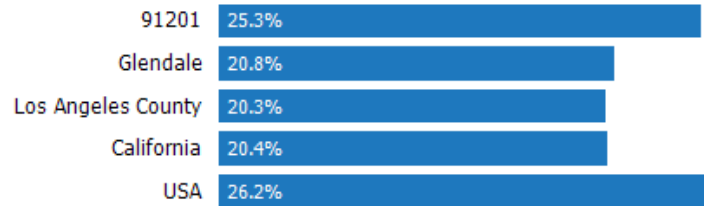

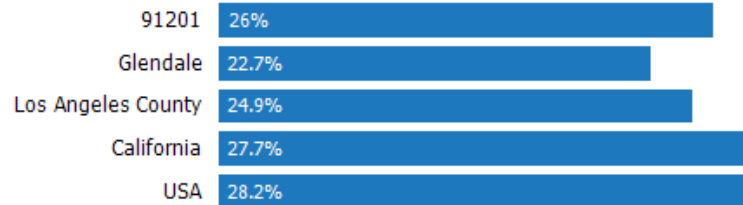

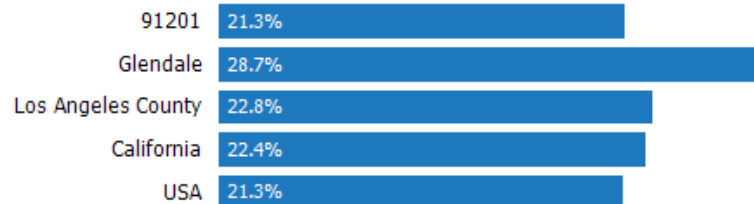

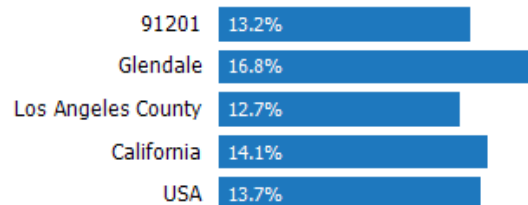

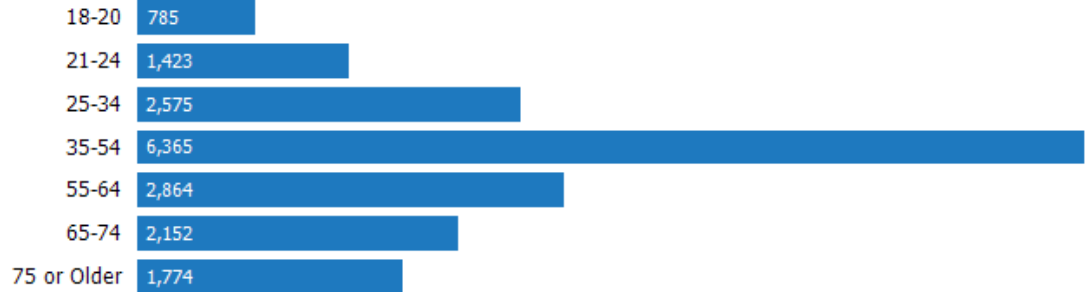
Population of Adults by Age Group

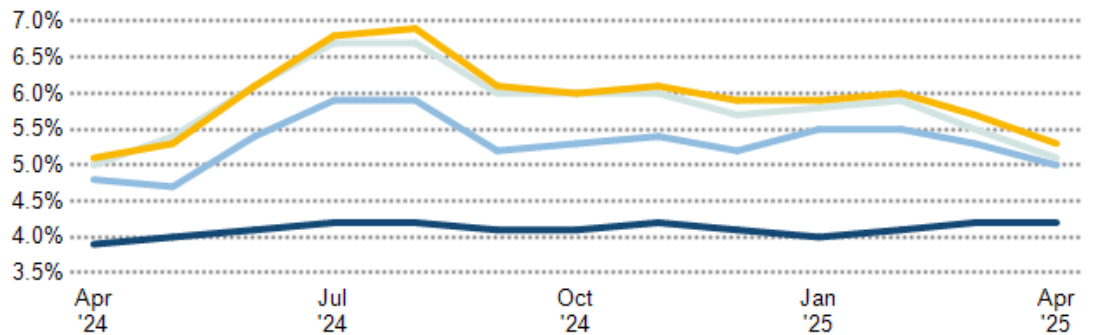
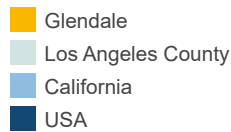

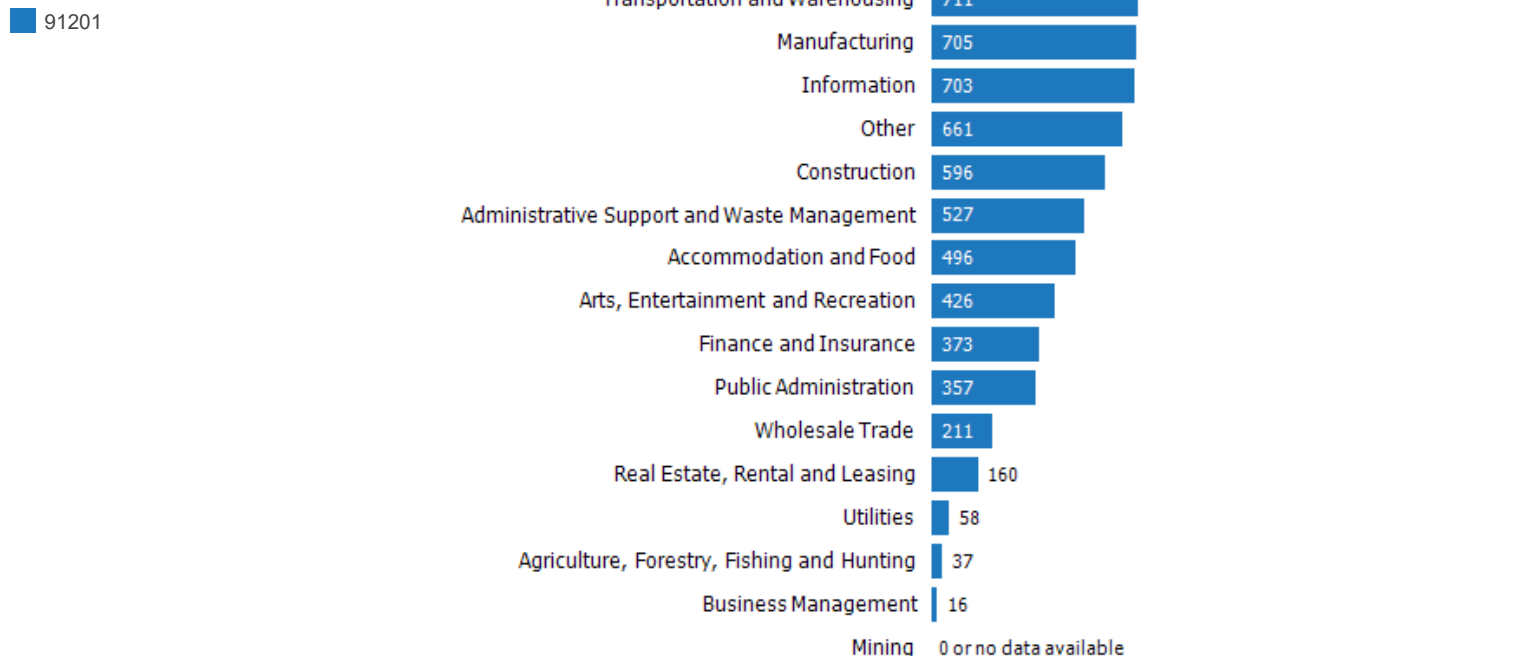


Occupational Categories

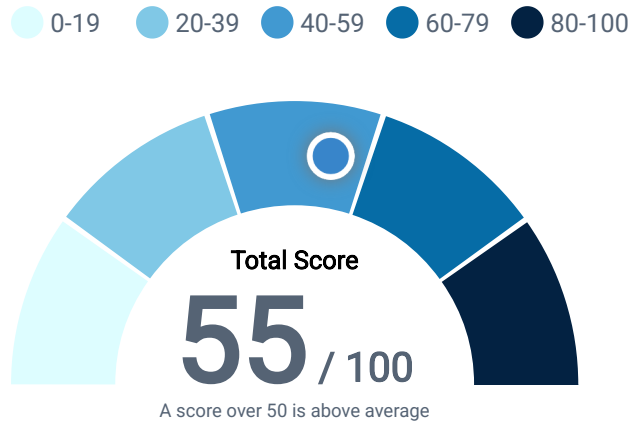
